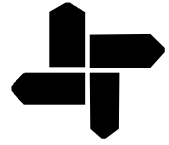

**CONSULTING SERVICES FOR PROJECT MANAGEMENT
CONSULTANT OF ELECTRONIC TOLL COLLECTION SYSTEM**

1. The Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka has received a Loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) which will be utilized for installation of multi-lane free flow electronic toll collection system (MLFF-ETC) contract under SASEC Port Access Elevated Highway (PAEH) Project. Part of this loan proceeds will be used for Consultancy Service for Project Management Consultant of Electronic Toll Collection System.
2. The executing agency for the Project is the Ministry of Highways & Road Development and Petroleum Resources Development and the Employer is the Road Development Authority (RDA).
3. The main objective of this consultancy is to assist the RDA in managing, implementing and operating the MLFF-ETC project.
4. The Project Management Consultant (PMC) includes, but not limited to, overall MLFF-ETC project management support, finalization of basic specification of MLFF-ETC system, support for creating implementation scheme and enabling environment, preparation of bid documents, support for evaluation of bids, review of contractor's detailed design, monitoring progress of the implementation, witness of contractor's testing and operational trials, verification of system operation, monitoring service performance and contract management.
5. The total length of the service will be 40 months, including 15 months for pre-bid and procurement stages, 18 months for MLFF-ETC implementation stage, and 6 months for MLFF-ETC initial operation stage.
6. The consulting services will require about 58 international person-months and 168 domestic person-months.

7. A consulting firm will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the ADB Guidelines on the Use of Consultants by the Asian Development Bank and Its Borrowers using Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) procedure.

8. Now eligible consulting firms are invited to indicate their interest in providing the required services. Interested consultants must prepare and submit an “Expression of Interest (EOI)” in a standard form, “Template for Expression of Interest (Consulting Firms)”, which can be obtained by contacting the EA or downloading from the ADB website (www.adb.org/Consulting/toolkit-template.asp) and click “Consulting Firms”). The EOI may be submitted either online through ADB's website or in hardcopy to the address indicated below.

9. For online submission: register with ADB’s CMS (Consultant Management System) at http://selfservice.adb.org/OA_HTML/adb/adbpos/jsp/ADBCMSHomepage.jsp and follow the instructions.

10. All requested information must be fill-in completely. For hardcopy submission: (1) obtain the “Template for Expression of Interest (Consulting Firms)” as instructed above, and (2) prepare and submit to the address indicated below in an envelope clearly titled – “Expression of Interest for Consulting Services Project Management Consultant of Electronic Toll System.

11. The received EOI on 03rd June 2019 will be considered for the evaluation and the Firms who have submitted the EOI are not required to re-submit the EOI. If the firm intends to revise their EOI, they may re-submit EOI on or before due date.
