INVITATION FOR SUBMISSION OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

Developing a Road Database, Digital Portal and Mobile Solution to Facilitate Road Development – 100,000 km project

Ministry of Highways and the Road Development Authority (RDA) have undertaken a task of rehabilitation of 100,000Km rural roads as per the Government's policy statement of "Vistas of Prosperity and Speldour". Given the significant increase in the rate at which roads are expected to be constructed, compared to the rate at which roads have been developed in the past, it has become imperative to streamline the processes and centralize the information regarding road construction through a digital portal. The digital portal, along with its accompanying website, are expected to enable key decision makers to get a holistic view of roads currently being developed and identify bottlenecks. The digital portal and the mobile application are also expected to be used by key stakeholders, such as Ministers, Parliamentarians, Provincial Council Officials, Grama Niladaris, and the general public to make requisitions to develop roads by marking them on Google Maps, subject to an allocated quota. This is anticipated to eliminate repetitive and overlapping requisitions currently being made by the manual requesting system. The Consultant to be employed will be selected under Quality Based Selection (QBS) in accordance with Government Guidelines for the Employment of Consultants.

The proposal shall include the following:

- 1. Detailed list of Five (05) enterprise level projects using web and mobile technologies, out of which at least One (01) should have used geographical mapping technology as per the template given in Section 4
- 2. Attach a copy of the business registration certificate issued by the Registrar of Companies, Sri Lanka.
- 3. Submit a copy of audited financial statements for the last three financial years.
- 4. Attach Three (03) local and Three (03) global enterprise-level customer references as per the template given in Section 4 of the RFP.

The general approach and methodology which you propose for carrying out the services covered in the Terms of Reference.
